



What does it mean to be fully vaccinated against COVID-19 in Canada?

People are considered fully vaccinated two weeks following their second dose of a Government of Canada-accepted COVID-19 vaccine, such as the Pfizer, Moderna or AstraZeneca vaccines, or 2 weeks after a single-dose vaccine, such as Johnson & Johnson's Janssen vaccine.

If you do not meet the above requirements, you are not fully vaccinated. Please continue to take precautions and enforce safety measures until you are fully vaccinated.
