



## COVID-19 Vaccination Requirements

**Effective October 30, 2021**, all travellers 12 years of age and older travelling on any Air Borealis flight may be required to produce one of the following:

- Proof of full vaccination (including valid paper documents, NLVaxPass or government issued QR code) with the last dose having been received on or before October 16th, 2021.
- Proof of negative PCR test taken within 72 hours prior to scheduled departure time, along with a government issued photo ID or two pieces of non-government issued ID; or
- Proof of positive COVID-19 PCR test taken 14 to 180 days before the scheduled departure
- Proof of a medical or religious exemption with an approved negative PCR test

It is important that all travellers confirm the name on their government issued photo ID or two pieces of non-government issued ID, as well as the name listed on the proof of vaccination/ QR code correctly match the name on the reservation. Travellers younger than 12 years of age travelling on a Air Borealis flight will take on the vaccination status of the parent or guardian travelling with them.

Travellers who provide false or misleading information may be subject to a fine of up to \$5,000.

**Effective November 30, 2021**, all travellers 12 years of age and older travelling on any Air Borealis flight may be required to produce one of the following:

- Proof of full vaccination
- Proof of a medical or religious exemption with an approved negative PCR test
