

Air Borealis Scholarship Program

Information for Applicants

PURPOSE

The Air Borealis Scholarship Program is designed to assist individuals interested in pursuing or continuing their education towards a career. These academic pursuits include but are not limited to post-secondary university, college, or high school diploma as a mature student.

CRITERIA FOR SELECTION

The award for this scholarship will be based on:

- Academic Ability
- Community Leadership and;
- Financial Need

The recipients of the scholarship are individuals deemed eligible by the scholarship committee. There will be two (2) scholarships:

- One for individuals who are members of the Innu Nation and;
- One for beneficiaries of the Labrador Inuit Land Claim Agreement

Note: *The decision of the Air Borealis Scholarship Committee is final. The committee members will not enter into follow-up or feedback conversation/discussion about the decision.*

AWARD

The value of the scholarship will be \$1,000.00 per year, renewable for up to three years – a maximum value of \$4,000.00. The scholarship will be paid in installments of \$500.00 on October 15 and February 15 of each academic year.

Recipients of this scholarship will attend an educational institution the same year to which they have applied. To re-new the scholarship, recipients must be enrolled in an educational program in consecutive years or forfeit the scholarship. Students must maintain a full time status at their educational institution and be in good academic standing to receive each installment of the scholarship. Proof of academic standing, with a grade report, is to be submitted no later than two (2) weeks prior to each installment of the scholarship i.e. October 1 and February 1. Failure

to meet these standards could lead to the forfeiture of the remaining portion of the scholarship. The final decision remains with the scholarship committee.

PROCEDURES

To apply for the scholarship, the following is required:

- A completed and signed Application Form
- A letter from the school principal or designate supporting the applicant's suitability for the scholarship
- A letter of support from another person
- A copy of the applicant's academic transcript
